	<b>10.7.1</b>	<p><b>Purpose</b> The purpose of this zone is to provide for housing, primarily in buildings with two dwellings in subdivisions with lanes for innovative, cluster housing, and compact housing.</p>			
	<b>10.7.2</b>	<p><b>Principal Uses</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• community care facility, minor</li> <li>• housing, single detached</li> <li>• housing, two-unit</li> </ul>		<b>10.7.3</b>	<p><b>Secondary Uses</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• bed &amp; breakfast</li> <li>• home business 1</li> <li>• home business 2</li> <li>• secondary suite only in single detached housing</li> </ul>
	<b>10.7.4</b>	<p><b>Subdivision Regulations</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The minimum lot width is 15.0 m, except it is 12.0 m for single detached housing and 7.5 m for a single unit of attached side-by-side two-unit housing.</li> <li>2. The minimum lot area is 500 m<sup>2</sup>, except it is 400 m<sup>2</sup> for single detached housing and 250 m<sup>2</sup> for a single unit of attached side-by-side two-unit housing.</li> <li>3. The maximum lot area is 845 m<sup>2</sup>.</li> </ol>			
	<b>10.7.5</b>	<p><b>Regulations for Principal Development</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum residential density is one dwelling per 250 m<sup>2</sup>, or two dwellings per lot, whichever is less. One secondary suite is permitted within a single detached house, but not within a two-unit house.</li> <li>2. The maximum number of dwellings in one building is 2.</li> <li>3. The maximum number of principal buildings on one lot is 1.</li> <li>4. The maximum site coverage is 45%.</li> <li>5. The maximum height is 10.0 m.</li> <li>6. The maximum number of storeys is 2.5.</li> <li>7. The minimum front yard is 4.5 m.</li> <li>8. The minimum interior side yard is 1.2 m (except not required for a common wall for attached side-by-side units of two-unit housing) and the minimum exterior side yard is 3.0 m. Where there is no direct vehicular access from a highway or lane to the rear yard or to a garage or carport, one side yard shall be at least 4.5 m.</li> <li>9. The minimum rear yard is 6.0 m.</li> </ol>			
Bylaw 8256	<b>10.7.6</b>	<p><b>Regulations for Accessory Development</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum total combined gross floor area of accessory buildings and structures on a site is 90.0 m<sup>2</sup>.</li> <li>2. The maximum height is 5.0 m.</li> <li>3. The minimum front yard is 4.5 m.</li> <li>4. The minimum interior side yard is 1.2 m and the minimum exterior side yard is 3.0 m.</li> <li>5. The minimum rear yard is 1.2 m.</li> </ol>
