Your Honour, on behalf of the College of New Caledonia Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee, I would like to pass on a thank you to the City engineers responsible for road markings.

I spoke to that office this spring about a concern regarding intersection marking. Our Heavy Duty Building is on the corner of Nicholson and 22nd Avenue. There is a pedestrian crossing for foot traffic crossing 22nd, but there has never been intersection painting at Nicholson. It has always been painted with only a centre line. After my visit to City Hall, the engineers inspected the intersection. When the road marking was done this year, the intersection was painted with a stop line and a pedestrian crossing.

We want to thank the department for their responsiveness. That corner has been a difficult area and a source of discussion in our College for many years. We appreciate how quickly the engineers responded.
