RECOMMENDATION(S):

That Council RECEIVE FOR INFORMATION the report dated January 23, 2018 from the General Manager of Engineering and Public Works titled “Starlane Park Playground Replacement”.

PURPOSE:

This report follows up on a request from Council made at the September 11, 2017 Open meeting for information on the replacement of the Starlane Park playground.

BACKGROUND:

At the September 11, 2017 Open Council meeting, a group of Starlane subdivision residents came as a delegation to provide feedback on the removal of the playground in Starlane Park. The group requested that the playground equipment that was planned for removal because it did not meet CSA safety standards, be replaced.

DISCUSSION:

In its review of the five (5) year playground replacement plan in the Capital Expenditure Plan, Parks Division has now included the replacement of the playground equipment at Starlane Park as a candidate for replacement in 2021.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The estimated cost for the replacement of the playground equipment at Starlane Park would be \$70,000.00.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION:

The replacement of the playground equipment at Starlane Park has now been included as a candidate in the five (5) year playground replacement plan in the year 2021 of the Capital Expenditure Plan at an estimated cost of \$70,000.00.


