- the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality; pursuant to subsection 90(1)(e) of the *Community Charter*.

PURPOSE:

For Council decision.

STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

“City of Prince George Council Procedures Bylaw No. 8388, 2011” requires that, subject to the provisions of the *Community Charter*, all meetings of council be open to the public.

Notwithstanding that general aim, the Council Procedures Bylaw and the *Community Charter* permit the closing of a meeting, or part of a meeting to the public if the subject matter relates to one or more of the matters listed under section 90 of the *Community Charter*.


The *Community Charter* and the Council Procedures Bylaw require that, before a meeting or part of a meeting is closed to the public, the Council must state, by resolution:

- (a) the fact that the meeting is to be closed; and
- (b) the basis under the applicable subsection 90 of the *Community Charter* on which the meeting is to be closed.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION:


It is recommended that this meeting be closed to the public to permit discussion of subject matter relating to the aforementioned subsection of section 90 of the *Community Charter*.
