The Hart Highland Winter Club requests the support of Prince George City Council by way of a resolution supporting our application for a grant from Northern Development Initiatives Trust.

The grant application is being made through the "Community Halls and Recreation Facilities" program for the Prince George Regional Development account. The requested grant of \$15,000 will cover approximately 1/3 of the cost of a second snow gun for the hill with the remainder being covered through our regular fund raising initiatives.

As you may know the Hart Ski Hill had a very successful year last year as a result of our phase one snow making project. The hill opened for 100 days with about 20 of those as a result of the snow we made. In all 1,400 kids learned to ski last year through both our SD57 program and our regular Ski School. Many of these kids would not have had the opportunity to learn to ski without the Hart and some will have life changing experiences as a result of this new found sport.

The City has been very generous in their efforts over the past number of years and would like to thank you sincerely for your generosity. We are hopeful that you will pass a resolution supporting this most recent application.

We hereby request that Council passes the following resolution:

- That the City of Prince of George supports the Hart Highlands Winter Club's grant application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust 'Community Halls and Recreation Facilities' program in the amount of \$15,000 from the Prince George Regional Development Account to support the cost of a second snow gun for use on the hill.
