E. Old Business

E.3 Accessible Parking Working Group

Ms. Maduranaygam, Transit Planner, entered the 2nd Floor Conference Room at 4:10 p.m.

Mr. Deveau provided an update on the status of the Accessible Parking Working Group. Discussion commenced regarding a proposed communication to be sent to City Senior Administration regarding accessible parking stalls located in City parkades not being up to accessible standards.

Ms. Blewett entered the 2nd Floor Conference Room at 4:18 p.m.

D. New Business

D.1 Guest Presenter: BC Transit and Accessibility in Prince George

Ms. Maduranaygam, Transit Planner, provided an overview of the Prince George Transit system and the accommodates made by the system to address accessibility. All fleet buses are accessible and work is underway to improve accessibility at the bus stops.

Discussion commenced regarding transit staff training regarding serving users with developmental disabilities. Ms. Maduranaygam advised that regular transit staff training is conducted by BC Transit and the operator, Pacific Western Transportation (PWT), however, she is unaware if that particular subject is addressed and will inquire with BC Transit.

Discussion commenced regarding the readability of the transit scheduled noting that schedules are posted too high at the bus stops. Ms. Maduranaygam will look into the height standards for schedules posted at bus stops.

The Committee encouraged simplification of communications and schedules for ease of use by individuals with

cognitive or developmental disabilities.

The Committee requested that access routes be assessed for accessibility. Mr. Sinclair advised that the City's Public Works Department considers accessibility when performing sidewalk enhancements and maintenance.

E.3 Civic Facilities and Parks Update

Mr. Sinclair advised he has not received any updates on the Pool or Library capital projects, but is working on getting a presentation for the committee to comment on accessibility.

Mr. Lamb advised she has previously sat on the ATAC committee but had difficulty attending as the space had limited accessibility and was not convenient to get to via transit.
