JOB TITLE: TRUCK DRIVER AUTOMATED GARBAGE SOLID WASTE SERVICES **SCHEDULE:** A

JOB SUMMARY:

The incumbent is responsible for skilled work in the operation and minor servicing of tandem axle right drive automated garbage collection vehicles, single axle automated garbage collection vehicles and associated divisional equipment, including manual garbage trucks, litter collection vehicles, tandem dump trucks and flat deck service trucks. Work is carried out under supervision with operator responsible for carrying out assignments operating relatively independently after receiving instructions from a supervisor. May be responsible for supervision of unskilled workers who assist in the completion of assigned work. Work is evaluated in terms of safe and efficient performance of duties and the attainment of desired objectives. Work is distinguishable from the TD3 – Automated Garbage by the routine operation of the tandem axle right hand drive automated collection vehicles. Performs related duties as required.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general supervision of the Foreman, Solid Waste:

Supports the division by:

- driving and operating an automated garbage truck on prescribed routes;
- driving and operating a manual collection vehicle on prescribed routes;
- driving and operating a tandem dump truck and associated attachments;
- operating litter collection equipment;
- checking mechanical condition of equipment and trucks;
- performing minor servicing, and maintenance;
- cleaning and greasing vehicle;
- reporting any damage or mechanical problems to supervisor;
- maintaining simple records in regards to the operation of divisional trucks and equipment;
- performing automated cart maintenance, litter collection, and litter container maintenance;
- collection of recyclables, collection of hazardous waste, and spill response
- complying with WCB standards for safe work practices;
- maintaining mileage and service records; and
- performing related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Completion of Grade 12. Unrestricted Class 3 with Air Endorsement.

Experience: One year of experience at the TD3 Level operating on public roadways. Qualified to operate the tandem axle right-hand drive automated garbage trucks. Safe work record in regards to equipment & vehicle operation.

Knowledge and Skills: Good knowledge of the methods and procedures used in the collection, transporting and unloading of solid waste, as well as the operational limits of the vehicle. Considerable knowledge and skill in the safe operation and precautions to be taken to avoid accidents in the operation of collection vehicles and divisional equipment in and around work sites, particularly in high public-use areas. Ability to exercise considerable independence of judgment and action in the operation of the equipment. Knowledge of the geography and street layouts of the City. Ability to supervise one or more subordinates. Ability to work within, and contribute to a collaborative team environment. The ability to deal courteously and tactfully with co-workers, management, and members of the general public. Demonstrated commitment to customer service. Ability to understand and effectively carry out oral and written instructions with a minimum of supervision. The ability to maintain records. The ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions. Sufficient strength and stamina to perform duties. Knowledge of WorkSafe BC regulations, occupational hazards and safe work procedures as it relates to the position, including but not limited to: bullying and harassment, working alone, and other significant hazards.
