KIDSPORT WEEK September 8 – 15, 2018

- Whereas:* KidSport provides sport registration grants annually to more than 7,300 kids who face financial barriers across British Columbia; and
- Whereas:* sport participation provides benefits beyond physical health to enhance social and academic performance and well-being, creates potential leadership and teamwork skills, and instills a sense of fair play; and
- Whereas:* KidSport helps remove financial barriers that prevent some children from experiencing the benefits of a season of sport by covering costs related to registration; and
- Whereas:* KidSport encourages and promotes partnerships and support at a local level between the local chapter and businesses, professional sport groups and organizations, and the community at large, by raising awareness and funds to support local kids; and
- Whereas:* KidSport is a long-standing and integral part of the City of Prince George community, aiming to annually help children and youth ages 5 - 18 to improve their physical and social health through experiencing the joy of sport participation.

Now therefore, as Mayor of the City of Prince George, I proclaim
September 8-15, 2018 as: “KIDSPORT WEEK” in the City of Prince George.
