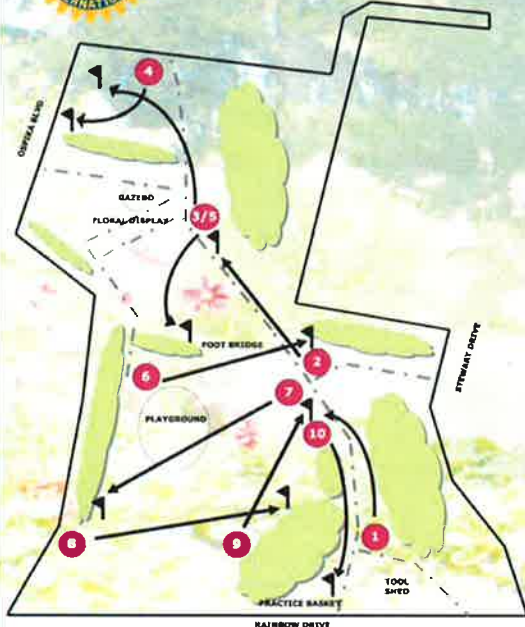

Rotary Disc Golf Course

Disc Golf is just like golf, only with a disc rather than a ball.
One point is counted each time the disc is thrown. The lowest score wins!

Begin at the first tee box. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range.

Mark where your disc lands by either turning the disc over or use another disc, now throw again.

The player that lands the farthest away from the basket always throws first.

The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next throw.

Discs landing in floral displays are out of bounds. The next throw must be made outside of the floral display.

Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the lie. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed.

You are successful at each hole when your disc is in the basket.

PARK USERS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY! Do not throw if there is a chance of an errant disc hitting anyone. Wait until all is clear or send out a spotter.

Do not stomp on bushes, trees or floral displays.

Use trash receptacles.

Leave your dog at home. Rainbow Park is a "No Dog Park".
