- *the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose; pursuant to subsection 90(1)(i) of the Community Charter.*
- *the consideration of whether the authority under section 91 [other persons attending closed meetings] should be exercised in relation to a council meeting; pursuant to subsection 90(1)(o) of the Community Charter.*
- *the consideration of information received and held in confidence relating to negotiations between the municipality and a first nation or a prescribed Indigenous entity, or between a first nation or a prescribed Indigenous entity and a third party pursuant to subsection 90(2)(b)(iii) of the Community Charter.*
