## **CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE**

## **BYLAW NO. 7420**

A Bylaw of the City of Prince George authorizing the expenditure of monies from the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund for capital improvements for the rehabilitation of intersection pavement on Highway 97 and 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenues.

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund established by "Capital Expenditure Reserve Bylaw No. 6931, 1998" of \$2 182 568, which amount has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Bylaw No. 7420 for the rehabilitation of intersection pavement on Highway 97 and  $5^{\text{th}}$ ,  $10^{\text{th}}$ , and  $15^{\text{th}}$  Avenues;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Prince George in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

- 1. The sum of \$89 000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund to finance the rehabilitation of intersection pavement on Highway 97 and 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenues.
- 2. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Capital Expenditure Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw No. 7420, 2002".
