

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7598

A Bylaw to authorize the borrowing of funds for the estimated cost of various projects under general, sewer, and water funds.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to undertake various projects under general, sewer, and water funds;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the various projects, including expenses incidental thereto, is the sum of **two million six hundred and seventy one thousand dollars** (\$2 671 000), which is the amount of debt intended to be created by this Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this Bylaw is twenty (20) years;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Blackburn Sewer Treatment Plant Diversion, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office, and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing;
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **one million dollars** (\$1 000 000);
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Blackburn Sewer Treatment Plant Diversion;
2. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Hart/Nechako Water Supply Improvement, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing;
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **one million five hundred and fifty four thousand dollars** (\$1 554 000);
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Hart/Nechako Water Supply Improvement;
3. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Exhibition Grounds Facilities Improvement, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing;

- a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **one hundred and seventeen thousand dollars** (\$117 000);
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights-of-way, licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Exhibition Grounds Facilities Improvement;
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "General, Sewer, and Water Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 7598, 2004".

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE **9th** DAY OF **August**, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS THE **9th** DAY OF **August**, 2004.
