

CITY OF PRINCE GEORGE

BYLAW NO. 7748

A Bylaw to authorize the borrowing of funds for the estimated cost of various projects under general, sewer, and water funds.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to undertake various projects under general, sewer, and water funds;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the various projects, including expenses incidental thereto, is the sum of **four million nine hundred and eleven thousand five hundred dollars (\$4 911 500)**, which is the amount of debt intended to be created by this Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this Bylaw is twenty (20) years;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Prince George, in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Blackburn Sewer Treatment Plant Replacement, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connections therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **two hundred and eighty thousand dollars (\$280 000)**;
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements rights-of-way licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Blackburn Treatment Plant Replacement.
2. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Exhibition Grounds Facilities Improvement, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connections therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **two hundred and twenty two thousand dollars (\$222 000)**;
 - b) To acquire all such real property, easements rights-of-way licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Exhibition Grounds Facilities Improvement.
3. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the PZ2 Cranbrook Hill/Nechako Reservoir, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connections therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **twenty one thousand dollars (\$21 000)**;
- b) To acquire all such real property, easements rights-of-way licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the PZ2 Cranbrook Hill/Nechako Reservoir.

4. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Road Rehabilitation Projects – Ferry Ave from Cemetery to South I/C ramp, 5th Ave from Wainwright to Edmonton, Victoria and 12th Avenue from N side of 8th, N side of 10th on Vancouver to N side of 5th and Parkwood on Victoria, Pacific St. from Terminal to Industrial, Ellison Drive from Ewert to 20th, Haldi Rd. from Hwy 16 to 400 meter East, Ferry Ave Underpass, 15th Avenue Overpass, Foothills Bridge and Road Rehabilitation Capital Projects, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connections therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- b) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **four hundred and fifty five thousand five hundred dollars (\$455 500)**;
- c) To acquire all such real property, easements rights-of-way licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Road Rehabilitation Projects.

5. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the Hart/Nechako Water Supply Improvement, generally in accordance with the plans on file in the municipal office and to do all things necessary in connections therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding **three million nine hundred and thirty three thousand dollars (\$3 933 000)**;
- d) To acquire all such real property, easements rights-of-way licenses, rights or authorities as may be requisite or desirable for or in connection with the Hart/Nechako Water Supply Improvement.

6. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “General, Sewer, and Water Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 7748; 2005”.
