myPG Community Grant Objective

To provide funding to registered not-for profits' projects and events that contribute to making Prince George a great community and promotes it as a great place to live and visit.

1. Project Goals and Activities*

How clearly does the applicant explain the project's overall goal and specific activities? Does the application demonstrate a well-thought-out plan, or are there gaps in logic or detail?

Scoring:

- **0 – Limited:** The project goal and activities are unclear or confusing. Significant gaps or missing information make the project difficult to understand.
- **1 – Satisfactory:** The goal and activities are described but may lack some detail or clarity. The project appears generally feasible, with minor gaps.
- **2 – Strong:** The goal is clearly stated, activities are well described, and the plan is thoughtful and complete with no major gaps.

Scoring Options: 0 - 2

2. Alignment with Criteria*

How clearly does the applicant identify who the project is for and explain how it will benefit them in alignment with the below grant criteria?

- Fostering community pride
- Promoting health and wellness
- Strengthening social connections
- Encouraging arts and culture participation
- Advancing equity, diversity, inclusion, and accessibility

- Supporting environmental sustainability and stewardship
- Promoting a safe, healthy, and clean community

Scoring:

0 – Limited: The target audience and benefit to community is unclear, and the connection to grant criteria is weak or missing.

1 – Satisfactory: The target audience and benefit to community is identified, and there is a general connection to one or more grant criteria.

2 – Strong: The target audience is clearly defined, and the project clearly demonstrates how it will benefit them in alignment with grant criteria.

Scoring Options: 0 - 2

3. Budget*

Is the budget clear, realistic, and complete? Does it cover all necessary costs for the successful delivery of the project?

Scoring:

0 – Limited: The budget is unclear, unrealistic, or missing key details. Major costs may be omitted or poorly justified.

1 – Satisfactory: The budget is generally clear and realistic but may be missing minor details or justifications.

2 – Strong: The budget is clear, complete, and realistic. All necessary costs are included and well justified.

Scoring Options: 0 - 2

4. Budget*

Based on the overall budget does the project provide strong value for the grant dollars requested?

Scoring:

0 – Limited: The project shows poor value for money; the impact does not justify the funding requested.

1 – Satisfactory: The project shows reasonable value for money, with moderate impact relative to the funding requested.

2 – Strong: The project demonstrates excellent value for money, with clear and significant impact for the grant dollars requested.

Scoring Options: 0 - 2
