MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Mail ballot voting is available to eligible residents and non-resident property electors.

Request forms to vote by mail must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 15, 2026.

Completed mail ballots must be received by the Chief Election Officer before 8:00 p.m. on General Voting Day (Saturday, October 17, 2026).

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

All eligible electors may vote either by mail ballot, at an advance voting opportunity, or on general voting day.

Elector registration will take place at the time of voting. To vote, you must meet the qualifications of a resident elector or non-resident property elector under the *Local Government Act* and provide the required identification.

Resident Electors

To register, you must:

- Be a Canadian Citizen; and
- Be 18 years of age or older on general voting day; and
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six (6) months prior to the day of registration; and
- Be a resident of the City of Prince George on the day of registration; and
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-Resident Property Electors

To register, you must:

- Be a Canadian Citizen; and
- Be 18 years of age or older on general voting day; and
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six (6) months prior to the day of registration; and
- Have been a registered owner of real property in the City of Prince George for at least thirty (30) days immediately before the day of registration; and
- Not be entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

If there is more than one registered owner of the property, a written consent form signed by a majority of owners must be provided. Only one non-resident property elector may vote per property. All registered owners of the property must be individuals.

Identification Requirements

All electors must produce two (2) pieces of identification, at least one of which must contain a signature, to prove identity and place of residence (and property ownership, in the case of a non-resident property elector).

Examples include:

| • BC CareCard** | • ICBC Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle License | • Any other document accepted by the Chief Election Officer |
| • Credit Card OR Debit Card | • Canadian Passport | • Metis Nation BC Citizenship Card |
| • Property Tax Notice | | |

**Driver's Licence or BC Identification Card with a BC CareCard on the reverse counts as one piece of identification.
